Secretary Mark Brooks presented the minutes from the April 2002 meeting held at the Garner Police West District Office in Garner, N.C. Motion made to accept minutes. Minutes were approved.

In Treasurer Rick Buchanan's absence, President Marilyn Stieneke reported a balance of \$16, 845 in the NCLEAN account. The treasurer's report was given and approved.

New Business

There was a brief discussion on the upcoming on-sites.

Discussion was held on updating the list that has been distributed in the past that gives relevant Statutes and other documentation for specific accreditation standards. President Stieneke will report on the issue at our next meeting.

Becky Flowers of the Cary Police Department made a presentation on the Bone Marrow Typing and Blood Drive, sponsored by Triangle Public Safety Agencies, to be held July 10th 2002, at the James S. Holshouser Building on the NC State Fairgrounds.

A motion was made for NCLEAN to contribute \$1000.00 to the Bone Marrow Drive. Motion seconded and passed.

After a short break, Gary Schrader of *Public Safety Computer Services NW*, in Milwaukee, Oregon, presented an alternative to ASAP, entitled *Total Accreditation Management and Evaluation Program (TAME)*.

Colonel Richard Holden of the NC State Highway Patrol thanked those in attendance for their involvement in the accreditation process and encouraged us all to "be a professional agency...be the best we can...and strive for excellence."

Our next meeting is scheduled for August 9th, 2002, in Salisbury.
